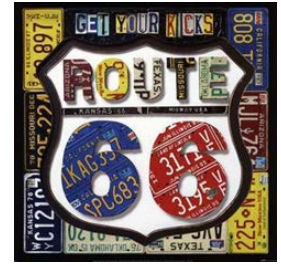

The amazing journey continues as the Landmark Moments Fellowship for Grades 7-12 social studies and language arts teachers and school media specialists begins another school year. The intent of the program is to deepen comprehension of traditional American history through the use of primary sources, the study of historical events, issues, personalities, turning points, and interpretations of events. Professional development for the 2016-2017 school year will focus on the history of the American West with summer field studies planned to the panhandle of Texas and the state of New Mexico.



The dates of the fellowship are:

- December 13-14, 2016
- March 6-7, 2017 (Tentative Dates)
- June 4-10, 2017 (National Field Studies)

All classes will be held on the University of Rio Grande campus. One to five graduate hours are possible for full program participation at the rate of \$140 per semester hour. Information will be distributed concerning this option on the first day of training. A survey of interest regarding the national study tour will also be provided.
