Driver's Education is offered to students that are ages of 15 1/2 years and older in the afterschool program. Parents are asked to attend a meeting before the program starts to get information about the program and hear all the benefits of taking Driver's Education during the STEPS program. Parents are informed that when their student signs up for afterschool the Driver's Education book work portion of the course will be paid for by the afterschool program. Students can finish their book work in 12 days and receive a completion certificate that is needed to take the driving portion of Driver's Education. If their child attends the afterschool program for 30 days or more the driving portion cost of Driver's Education will also be covered by the afterschool program which is a huge savings for the parents and their families. Their child's driving education will be no cost to the parents at all.
